If you've not yet tried a white Pinot from Oregon, here's a great opportunity. A distinctive style is emerging, positioned halfway between Pinot Blanc and Chardonnay. Some are styled more like a rosé; others, like this one, lean more toward white wine flavors. Here the soft entry is lightly buttery, with pretty fruit flavors of white peach and melon. There's suggestion of some barrel time in the scents of toasted cashews. The blend includes 6% Pinot Meunier and 3% Pinot Blanc. - PAUL GREGUTT
