Winemaker's Tasting Notes:

Aromas of blackberry, raspberry, cigar box, and cedar. A very focused yet rich palate of plum, currant, and black cherry intertwined with light yet sweet vanilla and mineral finish

Truffle Hill is one of the most unique places on the Left Coast Estate. Home to four acres of European Black Truffle-inoculated hazelnut trees, shrub roses and holly oaks, this dual varietal vineyard is planted with five acres of Swiss clone Wädenswil Pinot Noir.

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
