

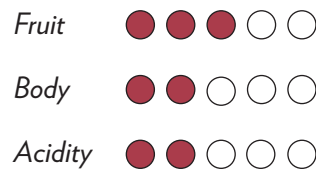

### VINEYARD NOTES

**Oregon** — Elevation: 272 - 453 feet

**Willamette Valley** — Varietal: Pinot Noir (Clones Dijon 777, 667 and 114), Pinot Meunier, Pinot Blanc

**Van Duzer Corridor** — Our rosé is a special label, we produce using close cousins

**Left Coast** — Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier. They balance each other out and create a well rounded rosé style wine, then we ferment and aged it in oak to push the creaminess on your palate and let the fruity floavors linger a bit longer.
