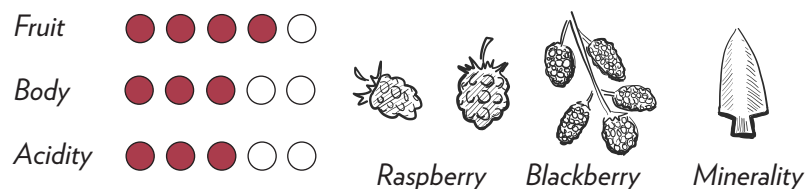
## 2021 CALI'S CUVEÉ PINOT NOIR
